

Proceedings of the State Environmental Clearance Committee (SECC) Meeting held on 04.07.2013 under the Chairmanship of the Principal Secretary to Government, Forest, Ecology and Environment Department

The Principal Secretary to the Government, Forest, Ecology and Environment Department and the Chairman of the SECC welcomed the members of the Committee to the meeting and the agenda was taken for discussion.

Agenda 1: Confirmation of the proceedings of the SECC meeting held on 17.05.2013

The meeting Proceedings of the Committee were confirmed as no comments were received on the proceedings.

Agenda 2: Action taken report on the proceedings of the SECC meeting held on 17.05.2013.

The Action taken report was noted.

Agenda 3: Subjects for consideration

Agenda: 3.1:- M/s. Unicast Autotech Pvt. Ltd., (FEE 45 ECO 2013)

M/s. Unicast Autotech Pvt. Ltd., have submitted an application for environmental clearance for establishment of Aluminum Die Casted finished parts of Automobile industry of capacity 1,000 MT/Month at Plot No. 223-226, Narasapura Industrial Area, Kolar Taluk & District with an investment of ₹. 33 Crores. The KSPCB has issued CFE vide letter No. KSPCB/SEO(Non-EIA)/CFE/LR-2012-13

The project proponent present explained the project. The proponent had informed that their project is an ancillary to Honda Motor Cycle & Scooter India Ltd. Further they have informed that they have proposed to collect completely the rain water in the entire area of their premises and had constructed rain water harvesting pond of two numbers. The KSPCB Officer present informed that the unit should establish an environmental cell headed by an environment engineer. After deliberation, the Committee decided to issue environmental clearance for the project with the necessary and required conditions.

Agenda: 3.2:- M/s. Chamundi Textiles (Silk Mills) Ltd., (FEE 6 ECO 2013)

M/s. Chamundi Textiles (Silk Mills) Ltd., have submitted an application for environmental clearance for the modernization of the industry i.e., change in the sequence of operational process for the production of Pure Silk furnishing & Pure silk dress materials (Silk Fabrics) of capacity 156 MTPA and up-gradation of existing effluent treatment plant facility in the existing premises at Plot No. Plot No. 66-A1, Hootagalli KIADB, Hebbal

Industrial Area, Mysore with an investment of ₹. 22.84 Crores. The KSPCB has issued CFE on 07.03.2005.

The project proponent present explained the project. The proponent had informed that their proposal is only for the change in sequence of operational process. The committee perused the compliance report submitted by Member Secretary, KSPCB vide letter dated 26.06.2013. The officers of KSPCB present in the meeting informed that the industry has complied with the conditions of earlier EC and CFO issued by DFEE & by the Board.

After deliberation, the Committee decided to issue environmental clearance for the project with the necessary and required conditions.

Agenda: 3.3:- M/s. Global Ecocarb Pvt. Ltd., (FEE 30 ECO 2013)

M/s. Global Ecocarb Pvt. Ltd., have submitted an application for environmental clearance for expansion of Coconut shell Based Activated Carbon from 2500 MT/PA to 5000 MT/PA at Sy. No. 12/3, Settikere Road, Bennayakanahalli Post, Tiptur – 572 201, Tumkur District with an investment of Rs. 10.38 Crores. The KSPCB has issued CFE on 28.07.2012.

Member Secretary, KSPCB vide letter dated 11.06.2013 had furnished the information on compliance status of CFO conditions issued by the Board and recommended for the issue of Environmental Clearance.

The project proponent present explained the project. The proponent informed that for their project ISO EMS 14001: 2004 certification is awaited. Fly ash generated in the project are being handed over to local brick manufacturers and they have huge demand for the fly ash generated.

After deliberation, the Committee decided to issue environmental clearance for the project with the necessary and required conditions.

Agenda: 3.4:- M/s. FMC India R & D Centre., (FEE 77 ECO 2012)

M/s. FMC India R & D Centre., have submitted an application for environmental clearance for their existing Research & Development laboratory carrying out bench scale experiments on organic synthesis and formulations. The target compounds are various intermediates and active ingredients useful for agrochemical and Specialty Chemicals Industry at No. 61/A, 1st Main Road, Industrial Suburb, 2nd Stage, Ward No. 11, Yeshwanthpur, Bangalore with an investment of ₹. 19.5 Crores. The KSPCB has issued CCO on 02.01.2013.

Member Secretary, KSPCB vide letter dated 11.06.2013 had informed that the industry has complied with the conditions stipulated in the CFO issued by the Board & hence issue of Environmental Clearance may be considered.

The project proponent present explained the project. They had informed that their R&D Centre which was earlier housed at Tata Institute Bangalore has been recently shifted to Yeshwanthpur Industrial suburb and they are engaged in the process development research work for intermediates, actives and formulations, Testing of raw materials and active ingredients and formulations for agrochemical use, Testing of raw materials and excipients for food and pharma use.

Quantities of chemicals handled in the laboratory: Average less than 0.5 Kg per day. most of the chemicals are bought from catalogs like Aldrich, Merck or equivalent Material generated is for testing purposes and has no commercial value. The hazardous waste will be handed over to M/s. Pai & Pai for disposal and treatment.

After deliberation, the Committee decided to issue environmental clearance for the project with the necessary and required conditions.

Agenda: 3.5:- M/s. Sandhar Automotives., (FEE 34 ECO 2013)

M/s. Sandhar Automotives., have submitted an application for environmental clearance for expansion the existing industry to manufacture additional products Fuel taps – 3.5 Lakhs pieces/annum and Latches – 4.5 Lakhs pieces/annum and also for installing sewage Treatment Plant of capacity 15 KLD at Plot No. 8, Bommasandra Jigani Link Road, KIADB Industrial Area, Bangalore with an investment of ₹. 1452 Lakhs. The KSPCB has issued CFE on 18.07.2009.

Member Secretary, KSPCB vide letter dated 11.06.2013 had informed that the industry as complied with the conditions stipulated in the CFO issued by the Board & hence issue of Environmental Clearance may be considered.

The project proponent present explained the project. They have informed that they are engaged in security systems i.e., production of locks for two wheelers and vision system i.e., production of mirrors for tow wheelers and All wastes will be handed over to vendors for reuse and recycling purpose. The Committee perused the compliance report submitted by MS KSPCB and After deliberation the committee decided to issue environmental clearance for the project with the necessary and required conditions.

Agenda: 3.6:- M/s. Manasa Sarovara Power Pvt. Ltd., (FEE 47 ECO 2013)

M/s. Manasa Sarovara Power Pvt. Ltd., have submitted an application for environmental clearance for Mini Hydal Power Plant of capacity 250 KW at Sy. No. 198, Near Shiramagondnahalli Village, 11.9th KM of Harihar Branch Chanal, Channagiri Road,

Bye-pass, Davangere Taluk & District with an investment of ₹. Two Crores & Twenty Lakhs. The KSPCB has issued CFE on 08.02.2006.

The project proponent present explained the project. The project proponent had informed that the project is on the Bhadra right bank canal. PLF is 45% and head is 5.8 m (3 drops within 300 m distance). The land required for the project for the project and transmission line to the substation (which is about 700 mts from the project site) is of irrigation department.

After deliberation the committee decided to issue environmental clearance for the project with the necessary and required conditions.

Agenda: 4.1:- M/s. Resil Chemicals Pvt. Ltd., (FEE 48 ECO 2012)

M/s. Resil Chemicals Pvt. Ltd., have submitted an application for environmental clearance for manufacturing of silicon based fluids of 135 MTPM, silicon based lubricant oils of 156 MTPM and formulation of textile finishing agent of 420 MTPM. at Unit –III, No. 53-57, Phase IV, KIADB Bommasandra Industrial Area, Anekal Taluk, Bangalore – 099. The KSPCB has issued CFE on 2008 & CFO on 2010.

Member Secretary, KSPCB vide letter dated 11.06.2013 had informed that the project proponent has stored the waste in impervious container and kept under the roof provided with concrete plat form. The actual quantity of ETP sludge is 48 MTPA (for which they had applied for obtaining authorization) and the industry has handed over entire quantity of ETP sludge generated for disposal by maintaining the records in Form-13.

Further, it is informed that with regard to unit at Plot No. 28 & 30, there is no generation of ETP sludge as there is no effluent treatment plant. Project proponent has complied with the authorization issued under HWM Rules by storing the waste in a impervious containers in a separate area, maintained records with labels.

With regard to the finger print analysis of the ETP sludge, the Board had informed that the Project proponent have submitted letter to them wherein they have enclosed sludge analysis carried out by M/s. Ramky and the analysis reveals that except for loss of Ignition and total Chromium all the other parameters are within the limit.

The Committee noted the report from the KSPCB who have enclosed the sludge analysis carried out by M/s. Ramky which reveals that except for all other parameters the loss of ignition and Chromium are within the limit. After deliberation, the Committee decided to consider the issue of environmental clearance for the project with the necessary and required conditions after obtaining a revised report from KSPCB regarding the issues

raised in the analysis report of M/s. Ramky. KSPCB also confirmed that the Hazardous waste in the ETP facility is being disposed off to the Treatment facility.

Agenda: 4.2:-M/s. SKOL Breweries Limited. (FEE 35 ECO 2013)

M/s. SKOL Breweries Limited., have submitted an application for environmental clearance for establishment of manufacturing unit with production capacity of 400 KLPD (10, 00,000 Hecto liters/Annum) at Kunthur Village, Kollegal Taluk, Chamarajanagar District with an investment of Rs. 250 Crores. The KSPCB has issued CFE on 15.02.2013.

The project proponent present in the SECC meeting held on 17.04.2013 explained the project. The Committee noted that the proponent has one more unit in Bangalore. The Regional Officer, KSPCB informed that there is a complaint from the surrounding residents regarding the odour problem and for that the proponent informed that they will shutdown the industry within 2 years. The Chairman instructed the Regional Officer, KSPCB to submit a detailed report regarding the complaint and commitment from the proponent to shutdown the industry within 2 years. The committee noted that a commitment regarding shutdown in future cannot be an excuse for non-compliance now leading to complaints from the public.

After deliberation, the Committee decided to re-consider the matter after obtaining the inspection report from the KSPCB and compliance by the Bangalore unit with the prescribed conditions.

Member Secretary, KSPCB vide letter dated 11.06.2013 had informed that the industry at Jalahally camp Road, Yeswanthpur, Bangalore is working since 1970 and engaged in manufacturing of beer of 4.0 Lakh HL/Annum. The consent issued under water and Air Acts is valid up to 30.06.2013. The industry has provided ETP and a part of treated effluent is used for gardening and excess is discharged into BWSSB Sewers. The treated effluent samples are conforming. The industry has Boilers of capacity 6 TPH and 5 TPH and DG sets of 750 KVA, 590 KVA and 500 AKVA. They have provided chimneys and APC measure as per stipulation. Issue of EC to SKOI Breweries at Nanjangud Taluk, Mysore district is recommended.

The project proponent present explained the project. The Committee perused the compliance report submitted by the KSPCB and after deliberation the committee decided to issue environmental clearance for the project with the necessary and required conditions.

Agenda: 4.3:- M/s. Solidus Hi Tech Products Pvt. Ltd., (FEE 39 ECO 2013)

M/s. Solidus Hi Tech Products Pvt. Ltd., have submitted an application for environmental clearance for establishment of new industry to manufacture Sheet Metal

Pressed Components with Powder coating of capacity 250 tons/annum at No. 33, 1st Phase Jigani industrial Area, Jigani, Bangalore with an investment of ₹. 18.74 Crores. The KSPCB has issued CFE on 27.01.2010.

Member Secretary, KSPCB vide letter dated 26.06.2013 had informed that the authorities or disposing the domestic sewage through septic tank & soak pit and the trade effluent shall be handed over to CETP owned by M/s. Lidkar Tanners Enviro Control Systems Ltd., for further treatment & disposal. They have also installed required pollution control equipments for all the Air pollution sources. They have stopped the Phosphating activity from 15.05.2013 and the same is being out sourced to M/s. Glace Tech India Pvt. Ltd., Plot No. 6, Bommasandra Jigani Link Road, Industrial Area, Anekal Taluk, Bangalore Urban District. They also placed order for supply of scrubber for the installation to the Phosphating section, and issue of recommended environment may be considered.

The project proponent present explained the project. The Committee perused the compliance report submitted by the KSPCB. The Committee noted the report of KSPCB and the project proponent that the operation of the Phosphating unit had been kept in abeyance pending grant of the Environmental Clearance. The Committee observed that the KSPCB confirmed that M/s. Glace Tech India Pvt. Ltd., is fully complied with environmental conditions. After deliberation, the Committee decided to issue environmental clearance for the project with the necessary and required conditions.

Agenda: 4.4:- M/s. Bill Forge Pvt. Ltd., (FEE 23 ECO 2013)

M/s. Bill Forge Pvt. Ltd., have submitted an application for environmental clearance for establishment of new industry to manufacture automotive components of capacity 220 MT/month at Plot No. 86 (M&N)/4, KIADB Industrial Area, 1st Phase, Jigani Village, Anekal Taluk, Bangalore with an investment of Rs. 13.79 Crores. The KSPCB has issued CFE on 27.11.2012.

The project proponent present in the SECC meeting held on 17.04.2013 explained the project. The proponent informed that they have 4 units in Bangalore out of which 2 are in Jigani, one in Bommasandra and the other one in Attibele. They have electric oven and no casting, no chroming is involved. The Committee directed the MS KSPCB to provide compliance report regarding the earlier EC/CFO conditions for the other units of Bill Forge. The Committee decided to re-consider after obtaining the detailed report from KSPCB.

The Committee perused the Compliance report submitted by KSPCB vide letter dated 04.05.2013 and found that units of M/s. Bill Forge at Plot No.7C Attibele industrial

area and at Plot No.9C KIADB Industrial area of Anekal Taluk are not fully complying the conditions of the CFO and hence after deliberation the Committee decided to defer the EC proposal and decided to take up the subject after the industry fully complies with all the conditions of CFO.

Agenda; 4.5;- M/s. Janatha Fishmeal & Oil Products, (FEE 93 ECO 2012)

M/s. Janatha Fishmeal & Oil Products., have submitted an application for environmental clearance Expansion/Modernization of their existing industry for increasing the production of Fish meals 10 TPD to 100 TPD" & Fish Oil from "1 TPD to 40 TPD" in the existing premises at Sy. No. 34/6, 34/5, 34/4, 34/11, 34/2, 34/3, 34/7A, 36/9A, 36/5, 36/10, 37/5, 37/4, 37/3, 37/2, 37/1A, 37/1B, 37/7A, 37/7B1, 37/7B2, 37/7C, 37/6, 37/8, 37/9, 39/11 and 40/4, Kotathattu Village, Udipi District, with an investment of `20.8 Crores. The KSPCB has issued CFE on 11.06.2012.

The Chairman of the SECC had informed that the applicability of CRZ norms, and the details furnished by the project proponent has to be ascertained by the concerned and to be processed on the file. These are matters that do not fall within the preview of the SECC. Since the details furnished are yet to be verified, the Committee after deliberation decided to defer the subject.
